



## Tournaments & Seasonal Schedule 2014

### **Hamptons Classic *Hamptons\****

**March 14-16**

**Attendance 46 Players**

The Hamptons Classic is an adult level 4 event with singles, doubles, and mixed doubles. Players are typically from around South Carolina, but we will occasionally have players join from neighboring states, such as Georgia and North Carolina.

### **SCISA Open**

**April 8-9**

**Attendance 120 Players**

The South Carolina Independent School Association (SCISA) is a non-profit association of independent schools such as Wilson Hall and Thomas Sumter Academy. This tournament consists of boy's and girl's singles, doubles, and mixed doubles.

### **Conference Carolinas Championship**

**April 24-27**

**Attendance 160 Players**

Conference Carolinas is a NCAA Division II athletic conference consisting of 12 collegiate teams from North and South Carolina as well as Tennessee. The top eight Men's and Women's teams compete for the championship.

### **Iris Jr. Championships *EMS-Chemie\****

**State Level 3 Junior Event**

**May 9-11**

**Attendance 104 Players**

This event pits some of South Carolina's best junior tournament players against each other as they prepare for the state qualifier later in May. The winner of the Girls' 18s will receive a wild card slot into the main draw of the Palmetto Pro Open.

### **Palmetto Pro Open Women's 10k Pro Circuit**

**May 17-25**

**Attendance 95 Players**

Women ages 14-28 from over 20 countries will participate in this \$10,000 USTA Pro Circuit event. Often players from this tournament continue to succeed and emerge as some of the top players on the big circuit. Last year three of our former players competed at the 2013 U.S. Open. In the main draw, 16th seed Sloane Stephens lost to Serena Williams in the fourth round.

### **USTA Zonal Team Championship**

**National Level 2 Junior Event**

**July 3-7**

**Attendance 144 Players**

Zonals is a national competition that brings together the top 144 players in the 12 and under division from four sections (Southern, Caribbean, Mid-Atlantic, Florida). They compete for four days in a round robin format and crown a champion on Sunday when the top two teams are paired based on the results of the round robin competitions.

### **Chuck Kriese's Total Tennis Training**

**July 21 - 25**

**Attendance 48 Players**

Former Clemson Coach and current Citadel Coach, Chuck Kriese, leads juniors in a week of tennis drills and play.

### **Palmetto Tennis Center Invitational**

**September 12-14**

**Attendance 160 Players**

College players from 12 different universities in North and South Carolina as well as Tennessee will meet for this event.

### **USTA ITA Southeast Regional Championships**

**September 26-29**

**Attendance 400 Players**

Individual tournament for players throughout the Southeast. Participating conferences are Conference Carolinas, Peach Belt, and South Atlantic Conference.

### **SCISA Girls State Championships**

**October 17-18**

**Attendance 96 Players**

The South Carolina Independent School Association (SCISA) is a non-profit association of independent schools such as Wilson Hall and Thomas Sumter Academy. This tournament consists of girl's 2A and 3A state semi-finals and finals matches.
