The Vietnam Traveling Memorial Wall will be on display throughout the Sumter Iris Festival **until Memorial Day, Monday, May 27**. The Opening Ceremony takes place at 5:30 p.m. on Friday, May 24.

The Wall, a 3/5 scale replica of the famed Vietnam Memorial in Washington, DC, is six feet tall at the center and stretches 300 feet long. As stated on the Traveling Wall website, the reproduction "stands as a reminder of the great sacrifices made during the Vietnam War. It was made for the purpose of helping heal and rekindle friendships and to allow people the opportunity to visit loved ones in their hometown who otherwise may not be able to make the trip to Washington, DC."
