

Please make sure that all persons in your group know your line up number. Become familiar with the information in this letter and share it with the members of your group.

Thank you for participating in this Shrine Day Celebration!!

Parade Rules:

1. All Parade entries are responsible for their own vehicles and signage. (Shriners will not provide signs or towing vehicles for commercial floats rented from the Shriners.
2. All entries **MUST HAVE LIGHTING**, including all vehicles, floats, bands, and each individual person.
3. All participants must ride in a vehicle or trailer/float due to safety precautions. Exceptions include large groups, ex: bands and dance schools.
4. All traffic laws must be obeyed before, during, and after the parade. All drivers in the parade must have a valid driver's license.
5. All units must keep pace with the other units ahead of them. Any entry which causes a gap may be asked to exit the parade. **No person or vehicle may enter into the parade once the parade or your unit has left the Sumter County Civic Center.**
6. All units must proceed at a safe speed. Any units seen being unsafe will be asked to exit the parade immediately. Participants must have a valid driver's license in order to drive the parade route.
7. All participants will not throw any paper goods, candy, cans or bottles of any type on the parade route. If any unit is caught throwing anything, they will be asked to exit the parade.
8. All flags, signs, banners, or insignias must be in good taste and must meet with the approval of the parade committee. The Shriners reserve the right to refuse entry to any unit deemed inappropriate for this family oriented event.
9. Participants here by agree to indemnify the Shriners of North America, Jamil Shrine Temple, Jamil Streakers, the City of Sumter, Sumter County, The Shrine Day Parade Committee and their members, subsidiaries, sponsors and associates in case of damage or injury.

Please be aware of the rules and share this information with each individual member in your parade unit. We do not want any accidents. Safety is our number one priority with it being a night parade.

Line-up:

Lineup will be in the parking area of the Sumter County Civic Center on Liberty Street. All participants will enter on West Oakland Avenue at the back gate. Please be in position at 7:00 pm. You may arrive early to avoid traffic.

How to Enter:

Access the Sumter County Civic Center at the back gate on West Oakland Avenue. Persons dropping off parade participants will enter the Civic Center area the same way. (No Exceptions)

Parade Route:

Parade will start at the Sumter County Civic Center at 8:00 pm, turn left onto Liberty Street, turn right onto Alice Drive, turn right onto Miller Road and exit left onto University Drive.
