1. **OA-12-07 ELECTRONIC GAMING, INTERNET SWEEPSTAKES, AND OTHER USES RELATED TO SIMULATED GAMBLING DEVICES**
Receive comments regarding a request to amend the City Zoning and Development Standards Ordinance to define, develop standards, and permit establishments in select zoning districts where customers use electronic machines, including but not limited to computers and gaming terminals, to conduct games of chance and other games which simulate gambling or simulate games of chance, where the use of sweepstakes promotions are offered and revealed on the electronic machines, and where cash, merchandise or other items are redeemed or distributed, whether or not that distribution is determined by electronic, machine, or computer game played or by predetermined odds. These uses are sometimes described as Internet cafes, cybercafés, sweepstakes promotions, sweepstake parlors, and/or adult gaming.
