Job Purpose: Supervises and performs manual labor in maintaining stormwater boxes, lines, outfalls, ditches, and other drainage features.

- Inspects, repairs, maintains, and cleans stormwater related infrastructure.
- Develops and implements weekly work schedules and tasks assignments for stormwater crew.
- Operates and utilizes various heavy equipment and supplies.
- Performs chemical treatment of ditches, ditch lines and rights of way.
- Conducts regular inspections of all City maintained stormwater infrastructure to verify system components are working as they are designed.
- On-call to fill-in as needed and required to be available during inclement weather or any other emergency.
- Performs exceptional service to internal and external customers.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Ability to operate heavy equipment and supplies to include backhoe, mini excavator, dump truck, Vactor Truck, pickup truck, shovel, chemical sprayer, boat and outboard motor, and other equipment as needed. Must obtain CDL License and Non-Commercial Pesticide Applicators License within one (1) year of hire. Ability to work with the public.

<u>Minimum Qualifications</u>: High School Diploma and at least 4 - 5 years experience; or any equivalent combination of training and experience. Must possess a valid S.C. driver's license.
