

II. BACKGROUND

This is a request to rezone a +/- 0.19-acre portion of a larger 3.2-acre parcel (TMS# 249-00-06-004) from Light Industrial-Warehouse (LI-W) to General Residential (GR).

The subject property is shown in red on the location map to the right, with the portion of property requested for rezoning circled in red. See Exhibit 1 and the graphic on pg. 2 for more detail on the proposed rezoning area.



The subject property is located on the east side of Progress Street and has direct frontage on this road. The subject property is currently undeveloped.




Figure 1: Area subject to rezoning request (0.19-acres)

The applicant is requesting to rezone the property to General Residential (GR) in order to establish an access point for a proposed mobile home park (MHP) development being planned for the larger adjacent parcel (TMS# 249-00-06-005), which is already within the GR district. The proposed MHP development will also have a private drive connection to the existing Iris Winds MHP. Rezoning to the GR district is required to establish the Progress St. access point. Without the Progress St. access point, the proposed development will not meet Fire Code emergency access requirements. A preliminary concept plan for the MHP is attached to this report as Exhibit 2.


No residential uses, including MHPs, are permitted within the LI-W district. In the GR district, MHPs can be established subject to the conditional use review process, the special development standards for MHPs found in *Article 3.d.7.*, and all other applicable site development requirements.

The development of an MHP in this location will require connection to public water and sewer services. The applicant must coordinate with the City of Sumter Public Services Department to ensure proper access and compliance with utility requirements.

Zoning

The property is currently zoned LI-W. Properties to the north and east are zoned residential and industrial (combination of LI-W and GR). Properties to the west, across Progress St., are zoned LI-W. Properties to the south are zoned industrial and residential (LI-W and GR).

The purpose of the LI-W district is to accommodate wholesaling, distribution, storage, processing and light manufacturing in an environment suited to such uses and operations while promoting land use compatibility both within and beyond the boundaries of such districts.




The purpose of GR district is to accommodate higher density residential development and a variety of housing types on smaller lots. It should be noted that the GR district is the only residential zoning district that permits manufactured homes and MHPs.

An applicant is not limited by their stated use of the subject property. If rezoned, the applicant could establish any use allowed in the GR district subject to compliance with all required standards. See attached <u>Exhibit 3 - Use Table</u> for the full range of land uses permitted "by right", via conditional use approval, or via special exception approval.

III. COMPATIBILITY WITH THE 2040 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Sumter 2040 Comprehensive Plan shows that the property is in a Priority Investment Planning Area, specifically the Priority Economic Development Area.

The goal of the Priority Investment Planning Area is to more acutely identify, direct, and concentrate new development opportunities. The designation offers protection to the existing industrial parks and identifies additional locations based on input from the Sumter County Development Board.



Industrial, Manufacturing, Research, Campus-style Office Headquarters and other major job creators are included in this category.

While rezoning to a residential zoning district is not in direct alignment with the Priority Economic Development Planning Area policies it is noted the subject property in on the edge of the Priority Economic Development Planning Area and is in close proximity to land within the Suburban Development planning area. The proposed rezoning area is only 0.19-acres in size and directly abuts the GR zoning district. Additionally, the development proposed will mostly occur on the area of the adjacent tract that is within the Suburban Development Planning Area where such development better aligns with applicable land use policies.

IV. TRANSPORTATION REVIEW

The site has direct frontage on Progress St., an SCDOT owned/maintained roadway. The segment of Progress St. directly in front of the subject property is a paved 2 lane section that is functionally classified as an urban local roadway. Per SCDOT traffic count data from Station ID # 43-0705, the annual average number of daily trips near the subject property was 400 in 2024.

All future site development will have its transportation impacts fully evaluated at the time of site plan approval.


V. STAFF RECOMMENDATION


Based on the site location, the adjacent zoning and pattern of development to the west, rezoning a 0.19-acre portion of the subject property from LI-W to GR is not an unreasonable request. Staff notes that such a request will likely have minimal impact to the designated Priority Economic Development Area, will not impact adjacent LI-W zoned property via more restrictive setback requirements, and is reasonable given the context of the larger land area that is under ownership of the applicant.
