#### OA-25-03, Civic & Social Organizations in the Neighborhood Commercial District.

#### I. THE REQUEST

**Applicant:** Gerald L. Jenkins

Request: Amend Article 3, Exhibit 5 of the Sumter County Zoning &

Development Standards Ordinance in order to allow Civic & Social Organizations (NAICS 8134) as a conditional use in the Neighborhood

Commercial (NC) district.

#### II. BACKGROUND

Permitted, Conditional, and Special Exception uses for each established zoning district are outlined in *Article 3, Exhibit 5: Permitted Uses in All Zoning Districts* of the Sumter County Zoning & Development Standards Ordinance (the "Zoning Ordinance"). Currently, Civic & Social Organizations under North American Industrial Classification System Code 8134 (NAICS 8134) are not permitted in the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) district.

An Ordinance Amendment application was submitted by the applicant to allow for the establishment of such uses in the NC district. The submission of this application was prompted by a desire to use an existing building located within the NC district as a masonic lodge. Staff reviewed a request to re-establish power to the building for this purpose and determined that the application could not be approved, as the intended use is not permitted on the property pursuant to NC district use requirements.

NAICS defines Civic and Social Organizations (NAICS 8134) as establishments primarily engaged in promoting the civic and social interests of their members. Establishments in this industry may operate bars and restaurants for their members. Representative examples of uses falling within this NAICS category are – alumni clubs, automobile clubs, book clubs, civic associations, fraternal organizations (such a masonic lodges), garden clubs, parent-teacher associations, social clubs, speaking clubs, etc. A printout of the NAICS 8134 definition and corresponding use examples is attached to this report.

The stated purpose of the NC district is to meet the commercial and service needs generated by nearby residential development. Goods and services normally available in this district are of a "convenience variety".

Staff has reviewed the request against NAICS 8134 uses, the intent of the NC district, and the broader goals of the Sumter 2040 Comprehensive Plan. Upon evaluation, modifications to pull out automobile/motorcycle clubs from the general Civic & Social Organization (NAICS) grouping and separately list them in *Article 3, Exhibit 5* is proposed. Additionally, the

amendment request is crafted to require conditional use review for Civic & Social Organization (NAICS 8134) uses in the NC district, as all uses within this classification may not be appropriate for every site within the NC district. Because of this, demonstration that a use proposal can comply with the standard conditional use criteria found in  $Article\ 5.b.1.a - 5.b.1.f.$  is warranted.

#### **Proposed Text Amendment**

A strike-through of the proposed text amendment is attached as <u>Exhibit 1</u>. A printout of the NAICS 8134 definition and corresponding use examples is attached as <u>Exhibit 2</u>. The proposed amendments would impact the following sections:

Amend Article 3, Exhibit 5, as shown in red below:

The proposed change, if approved, would allow Civic and Social Organizations in the NC district with the exception of automobile/motorcycle clubs. A separate line item in the table is proposed for automobile/motorcycle clubs showing this use as conditional in the Limited Commercial (LC) and General Commercial (GC) districts, permitted in the Light Industrial-Warehouse district, and as a Conditional-500<sup>1</sup> (C-500) use in the Agricultural Conservation (AC) district.

#### III. STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission recommend approval of this request to the County Council. Civic and Social Organization can play an important role in the health and vitality of residential areas. Certain uses falling under this category may be neighborhood oriented depending on the mission of such an organization. The request is reasonable given the purpose of the NC district and the broader overarching goals of the Sumter 2040 Comprehensive Plan.


